The passing of Professor Patrick Omonua Erah (1962 - 2025), who served as the Editor of *Tropical Journal of Pharmaceutical Research* (TJPR), on 28 March 2025, followed a tough battle, for over two years, with the illness that ultimately took his life. He was a co-founder of the journal in 2001 and has held the editorship position since its inception.
